## From Washington, DC:

From the Capital Beltway (I-495)
Take the I-95 North exit;
10 miles to Columbia exit (MD Rte 32 West);
2.5 miles to Washington, DC, exit (US Rte 29 South);
1.5 miles to Johns Hopkins Road
Turn right at traffic light;
APL is located at next right immediately past
Texaco service station.

## From the Capital Beltway:

Take US Rte 29 North (Colesville Rd.); 12 miles to Johns Hopkins Road Turn left at traffic light; APL is located at next right immediately past Texaco service station.

#### From Baltimore:

Take Baltimore Beltway (I-695) to I-95 South exit; 10 miles to Columbia exit (MD Rte 32 West); 2.5 miles to Washington, DC exit (US Rte 29 South); 1.5 miles to Johns Hopkins Road, Turn right at traffic light; APL is located at next right immediately past Texaco service station.
